Welcome to our <u>Keystone Indoor Drill Association Show at Lower Dauphin on February 19, 2022</u>. Enclosed you will find contest information, including general rules and procedures, maps, directions and schedules. Please take a moment to double check the name and classification of your group on the Schedule. Also make sure your Show Title and Directors are listed correctly for the Announcer. Refer to the KIDA and Competition Suite websites for more information. Note that the performance schedule and timing is subject to change pending any last minute additions, deletions, or corrections.

Please be aware of the following:

- All KIDA rules apply.
- School rules state **NO SMOKING** in the building or anywhere on school property (*not even outside in the parking lot*). NO alcoholic beverages or controlled substances allowed in buildings or on campus.
- There should be NO food or drinks in the Gym, Warm Up Rooms or Classrooms.
- Student performers should NOT change into or out of uniforms in the Restrooms closest to the **Gymnasium** as these are for Spectators. They should change in Restrooms near the Band Room (500 wing) or near their assigned Classrooms.
- Directors should email Music Performance Recordings in MP3 file format to Dr. Richardson at krichardson@ldsd.org AT LEAST 5 DAYS PRIOR TO THE SHOW. Include the name and date of the show in your email, along with Group Name, so we can have them organized and ready for show day.
- **Sound Checks** are from <u>1:30-2:30 PM</u>, with the first performance at <u>3:00</u>. A Guard Awards Ceremony will be held during Intermission, and Percussion Awards at the end. (*Times are subject to change.*)
- Performing groups will enter the Gymnasium at the front left (from main Audience/Judges view) and
 exit at the back right. You will be allowed to unfold your mat to a vertical center line and move halfway
 on to the Gymnasium floor from left to right, as directed by judging staff.
- LD Booster volunteers will lead your group from your Classroom to Warm Up Rooms and then to the performance Ready Area outside the Gym.
- After your performance, your group and all equipment/props will immediately EXIT TO
 OUTSIDE for loading. You may want to have Chaperones bring along slip-on shoes or jackets for
 students. Read the NEW LOADING INSTRUCTIONS below!
- Judging information will be provided in Competition Suite.
- General Admission prices are \$10 for adults, \$5 for students and senior citizens.
- Face Masks are encouraged but optional, and Hand Sanitizer will be available throughout the school.

ARRIVAL AND CHECK-IN INSTRUCTIONS:

- We request that you schedule your arrival to Lower Dauphin for **NOON or later**.
- When you arrive at the LD High School, performers should be dropped off at the front of the school in the Bus Circle (YELLOW ROUTE on Map - enter from S. Hanover St. and turn right).
- See attached School Grounds Map for more parking info and School Map for show layout.
- Equipment trucks and trailers should stay to the left when entering from S. Hanover St. (BLUE ROUTE). A Parking Attendant will move barriers so they can pull up to unload at the back of the school, and equipment will be brought in Exit #14 near the Band Rooms.
- Trucks, Trailers and Buses should all park in the Lower Bus Lot down past the tennis courts.
- Upon arrival, groups should report to the **Registration Table** right inside the Main Front Entrance, where volunteers will greet you, help with paperwork, and guide you to an assigned classroom.
- Staff and Chaperones must monitor their **Classrooms**, and students should NOT be left there unsupervised. Please do not touch the teacher's desk or supplies or any equipment. All trash should be thrown away, and the room should be left in the same condition as when you arrived.
- During check-in, your group will be provided with 10 Admission Wristbands, including 2 specially
 marked for Directors. These must be worn to get into the Gym to watch performances. The 2 Directors
 are allowed to sit in the front audience bleacher section. Other staff, performers, chaperones and
 drivers must sit in the back bleachers. Anyone without a wrist-band must pay admission.
- Student performers should be present at Registration as they will be hand-stamped.

POST-PERFORMANCE AND LOADING INSTRUCTIONS:


- Following your performance, your group will exit the Gym at the back right, cross the hall, and **IMMEDIATELY EXIT TO OUTSIDE** to load your equipment in the Bus Circle.
- See attached Gym Layout Map for more details.
- In case of inclement weather, you may want to bring slip-on shoes and jackets for your performers.
- Give your equipment driver your performance time, or call them, so they are ready to pull up to the loading area as soon as you finish.
- You are expected to be able to load in **15-20 minutes**. If you think it will take longer, we recommend you park your truck/trailer further away and bring equipment to it. Please DO NOT block the loading area for a long period of time! Volunteers may ask you to move if you have been there for too long.
- To re-enter after loading, performers and staff will walk a short distance along the Bus Circle and come back in through the Main Front Entrance by Registration. If it is very cold, performers can wait in the main lobby or vestibule areas, and there is an overhang to protect equipment waiting to be loaded.
- NO performers, staff or equipment will be permitted to remain in the hallway outside the Gym or walk
 past the Guest Entrance or Admissions Table after performing. All equipment and props must be taken
 immediately outside. Please contact us ahead of time if you foresee this being a problem!
- Our goal is to keep that hallway clear so that groups do not encounter any delays as they are trying to quickly get off the Gym floor! We have made these changes based on feedback from prior shows, and we appreciate your cooperation.

Please pay special attention to the attached information about our **EQUIPMENT INSPECTION.** This information should be shared with all of your instructional staff.

There will be members of our Band Booster Association available to help you in any way possible. Just look for someone wearing a "Volunteer" badge or stop by the Command Center near the Café.

EQUIPMENT INSPECTION:

Due to major damage to our gymnasium floor in prior years at our indoor shows, it has been requested by our school administration that we as a booster organization do everything possible to ensure no damage occurs to our gymnasium floor again. We need your help to ensure the floor surface is preserved. Performing groups will be responsible for any damage they cause to the gymnasium floor.

We will be inspecting your equipment and props as you first enter the school and in the staging area prior to your performance. Please be courteous to our volunteer inspectors, as they will be courteous to you. If we find a piece of equipment that we feel does not meet our criteria, we will do our best to accommodate, but we suggest you check equipment prior to arriving at Lower Dauphin High School.

We are asking that all of your equipment meet the following criteria:

- All equipment with wheels must have wheels that are at least 1 inch in diameter.
- Please have rubber tips on all stands with metal feet.
- You should bring a **mat** to put down for extra floor protection.
- Any props, equipment, instruments or carriers that may do damage to our gymnasium floor will not be permitted.

If you have a piece of equipment that you feel does not meet these requirements, contact me immediately, and we will work with you to get your equipment up to our standard for use on our gymnasium floor. We sincerely hope that you can understand why we need to take this approach to ensure the integrity of our gymnasium floor. The Pennsylvania Turnpike (from East and West)

Exit 19 - Harrisburg East Interchange Take Route 283 East

Take Middletown/Hummelstown exit

Turn left at stop sign, go 2.5 miles

Lower Dauphin will be on the right

From the South:

83 North to 322 East to Hummelstown/Middletown Exit At the top of the ramp turn left Lower Dauphin will be on the right

From the East (Lebanon):

422 West to Hummelstown/Middletown Exit At the top of the ramp turn left Cross over the bridge and immediately turn right Go to the stop sign and turn right Lower Dauphin will be on the right

From the Northwest (Lewistown):

322/22 East to 81North to 83 South and 322 East. (Follow signs to Hershey) Take the Hummelstown/Middletown Exit At the top of the ramp turn left Lower Dauphin will be on the right

From the North and Northeast:

78 West or 81 South (78 West becomes 81 South)

Take exit for Route 39 interchange

Turn left and continue on Route 39 to Hersheypark Drive

Turn right on Hersheypark Drive (also Route 39)

Follow Hersheypark Drive (Route 39) until it ends at Hummelstown (past McDonalds and Wendys, Pizza Hut on the right)

Continue straight and take the ramp to the right for 322 West

Take the Hummelstown/Middletown Exit (about 1 mile)

At the top of the ramp turn left

Cross over the bridge and immediately turn right onto Middletown rd.

Follow to the stop sign and turn right onto Hanover st.


Lower Dauphin will be on the right

From the Southeast (Lancaster and Philadelphia):

Route 283 West to Hummelstown/Middletown Exit Turn right at stop sign and continue 2.5 miles Lower Dauphin will be on the right

Lower Dauphin High School Campus Map - Parking Instructions

- **Buses** and vehicles carrying performers should drop occupants off at the Front Main Entrance of the school in the Bus Circle (YELLOW ROUTE enter from S. Hanover St. and turn Right).
- Buses should then exit the Bus Circle, turn Left and continue down past the athletic fields and tennis courts, and park in the lowermost Bus Lot.
- Equipment Trucks and Trailers should stay to the Left when entering from S. Hanover St. (BLUE ROUTE). A Parking Attendant will move barriers so they can pull up by the sidewalk at the back of the school to unload and enter near the Band Room.
- Trucks and Trailers should then proceed around the back of the school, turn Left at the athletic fields and tennis courts, and park in the lowermost Bus Lot.
- When called to come for loading, Trucks and Trailers should drive up to the Bus Circle (RED ROUTE), staying off to the Right side when parking so as not to completely block the lanes.
- **Guest vehicles** can enter off S. Hanover St., staying to the Left and proceeding behind the school to Guest Parking areas. Guest vehicles can also come through the entrance off Parkside Ave./Royal Terrace and Division St., staying to the left. Guests can enter at the back by the Gazebo.
- Traffic will be one-way through the BLUE ROUTE from S. Hanover St. to Guest Parking.
- Limited **Handicap Parking** will be available behind the school (BLUE ROUTE). A parking attendant will check your placard and move cones/barriers for you.

Prop Storage: Equipment and props will be lined up in the main Hallways or near your assigned Classroom. A host will guide you to your prop storage area upon arrival.

Flow: A Booster volunteer will assist with movement during the day. In general, you will initially be directed to an assigned Classroom; from there you will be moved to a Warm Up Room (guard will go to a body only warm up area followed by an equipment warm up area); then to the Ready Area outside the Gymnasium; followed by your performance in the Gym. Immediately after your performance, you will exit the Gym at the back right, cross the hall, and go through the exit doors to the outside Loading Area. All equipment and props must be removed from the school through these exit doors by the Gym immediately following your performance. All performers and staff will exit to outside through these same doors and can re-enter through the school's Main Front Entrance off the Bus Circle.

Electrical: Outlets are located front and center in the Gym. There is an outlet front and center in the Band Room. There are electrical outlets all around the other Warm Up Rooms in expected areas.

Costume Changes: Performers should use the Restrooms near their assigned Classroom or near the Band Warm Up Rooms for costume changes and make-up. Do NOT change in the restrooms closest to the Gym as these are for spectators. Do not allow glitter or make-up dust to drop in classrooms!
