TICKETS

Tickets will be available at the door the day of the event. The cost for admittance is as follows:

Adults	\$20.00 per session
Students	\$15.00 per session with a valid ID
Senior Citizens	\$15.00 per session/65+ with ID
Adults	\$35 All day Guard Admission
Children Under Three (3)	Free
Championships Programs	\$5.00

CHAMPIONSHIP PASSES

When you arrive at unit registration, you will be issued ten (10) wristbands, per unit, for entry into the show (two frontside and 8 handler). The check-in registration table will have the number of student performers, per the unit roster that you submitted, and each of these students will be given a wrist band. Everyone else (i.e. instructors, handlers, chaperones, bus drivers, etc.) will use the wristbands from your packet or must purchase one in the main lobby. No other passes will be accepted. Admittance to the show will only be granted to those person(s) wearing wristbands. The handler & performer wristbands permit access to the arena on the participant side only, except during your unit’s performance.

PLEASE NOTE: EVERYONE MUST have a WRISTBAND to enter the Championship Arena – INCLUDING PERFORMERS

You will be asked to show your wristband when entering the arena. Only spectators who have purchased a spectator wristband will be seated on the spectator/judging side of the arena. All other wristbands will only be allowed access on the sides of the gym (no backside seating). NO EXCEPTIONS!

PARKING

Please see the attached map as to where units should be dropped off in the front of the school (main

entrance). Trucks drop off equipment in the back of the school (Tolbert Ave) & both will be directed to the designated parking areas for buses & trucks. A shuttle will be provided to get drivers back to the school.

TIMING AND WARM-UP SCHEDULE

Please be flexible with your scheduled warm-up times. Be prepared for the possibility that your performance schedule could change. Allow for schedule changes when planning for your arrival. Color guards will be able to perform sound checks before the show begins, after the awards ceremonies or during any break.

No playing of instruments or spinning of equipment is allowed anywhere in the school outside of your scheduled warm up time. Units cannot wander the facility to locate any additional warm up areas. ALL units will be given plenty of time in warm up areas for stretching & equipment warm up.

Percussion groups will be permitted to go outside if they choose if they do not block any entrances or parking areas. You will ONLY be to use the designated entrances/exits on TOLBERT AVE when entering & exiting the school – you will not be able to come in/out the closest door assessable.

There are 3 percussion warm up areas (see map), if you are in area #3 you will enter it off the cafeteria. All percussion equipment will be stored in the old gym until your scheduled warm up, please make sure you give yourself enough time to get equipment, travel to warm up, etc. To avoid pedestrian traffic in the main hallway from café to gym, Percussion units will be directed back through the old gym to travel to the holding area & then performance in main gym. If you choose to warm up outside it is YOUR responsibility to be at the gate 9 min before your performance time.

UNIT DESIGNATED HOUSING ASSIGNMENTS

Each group will be assigned to their own housing classroom. Please be respectful of the room & make sure is CLEAN when you leave. If you are applying

glitter and anything that will make a mess, please make sure application takes place in one of the rest rooms.

On check-in, a driver’s license will need to be handed in to be given a room key and gain access to your housing. The license will be kept on hold until the room is vacated and the key is turned in at the end of the day.

Adult Monitor

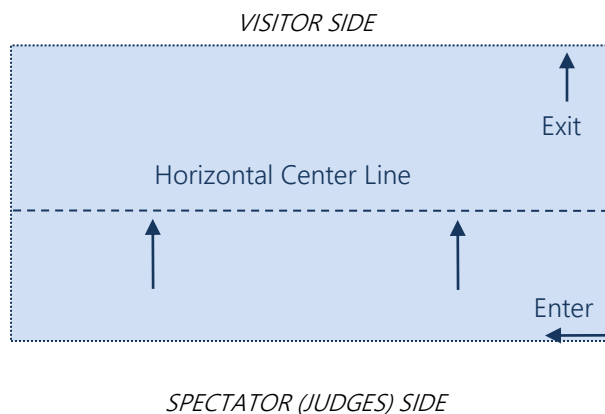
An adult (instructor or parent) MUST be with the students at all times when in the housing area.

Changing Facilities

Changing into uniforms can take place in your housing area/room or in one of the restrooms.

PERFORMANCE ENTRANCE AND EXIT

For the 2017 Championships, the horizontal entrance rules will be used. Units will enter from the right/front spectator’s side of the gym. Units will exit on the back-right side. See chart below.



FOOD & CONCESSIONS.

Food is being served in the cafeteria throughout the day (morning to evening). NO OTHER OUTSIDE FOOD OR BEVERAGES ARE PERMITTED TO BE BROUGHT IN THE BUILDING. There will be monitors to ensure adherence to these requirements. Tailgating in the

parking lot areas or any type of cooking on school property is also not permitted.

There will also be a concession stand open behind the back stands in the KIDA Market Area.

FIRST AID

A first aid and EMT station will be made available for KIDA Championships. The EMT station will be located on the Ground Floor of the Performance gym near the unit exit door. Please see them for any first aid needs, including ice.

VIDEO TAPING POLICY

Personal video taping IS NOT PERMITTED at Championships. Each unit will be permitted to use their season video pass for one person to record at Championships for educational purposes. Anyone caught videotaping at Championships will be asked to stop & if they fail to cease they will be asked to leave the premises by security and not refunded their ticket price. PLEASE MAKE SURE YOU INFORM YOUR PARENTS.

PERFORMANCE DVDS

PHOTOGRAPHY

After each unit’s performance, photographers will be taking pictures of the groups. This year, spectators and students will be able to purchase prints of these photos on the day of KIDA Championships and receive the print that day. They will be set up in the hallway between the gym and cafeteria. You can go before or after your performance to get your picture taken.

FULL RETREAT

KIDA Championships will have a full retreat for the Percussion and both Color Guard sessions. After the final percussion group and final guard in each session, all performers are to remain in the side stands, ONLY CAPTAINS are to report to the holding area outside the entrance to the gym to set up for a full retreat. Once all the captains are paraded in for retreat we will ask the rest of the performers to exit the stands & enter the floor. Please be sure to instruct your performers on where they need to be at the designated times. Staff members should also be on hand to help with the medal ceremony if your unit finishes in first, second or third place.

Championship plaque will be awarded.



ROSTER UPDATES AND LICENCES

On check-in, you will be asked to verify the number of performers in your unit. Please make sure you update your roster if it has changed since you submitted it at the beginning of the season.

Also on check-in, you will need to give a driver’s license to keep on hold to get your room key. Please remember to turn in your key at the end of the day to get it back.

CHAMPIONSHIP AWARDS

The awards for the 2018 KIDA Championships will be similar to past years. These awards, featuring the KIDA Championship logo, will provide performers and ensembles with a timeless keepsake of their KIDA Championship experience.

Medals

KIDA will be presented to First, Second, and Third places in all competitive classes.

Champion Banner

For the champion in each competitive classification (First Place), the KIDA Championship banners donated by Field & Floor FX will be awarded.

Chambersburg Area School District **ATHLETICS**

CASHS Trojan Stadium & Gymnasium Event Regulations

Effective September 29, 2017, all guests to the CASHS Trojan Stadium & Gymnasium will be subject to the following regulations before entering athletic events.

Bags

One small clutch bag or purse permitted



No Larger Than 6.5" x 4.5"

Students - NO BAGS

Diaper bags, walkers, and other medically necessary items will be permitted following a detailed search.

Additional Information

- Clothing, blankets, cameras, and cell phones will be permitted, but subject to search.
- Seat cushions will be permitted but must not exceed 18 inches wide and cannot contain pockets, zippers or concealable areas.
- There are no provisions to leave or check items at the gates. Fans will be asked to take prohibited items back to their vehicle.
- Gates open 90 minutes prior to Varsity Football contests and 60 minutes prior to all other contests. Please give yourself time to park and proceed through the bag check.
- Students must be accompanied by an adult. (8th grade or lower)
- All spectators are to remain seated unless in line at concessions or restroom.

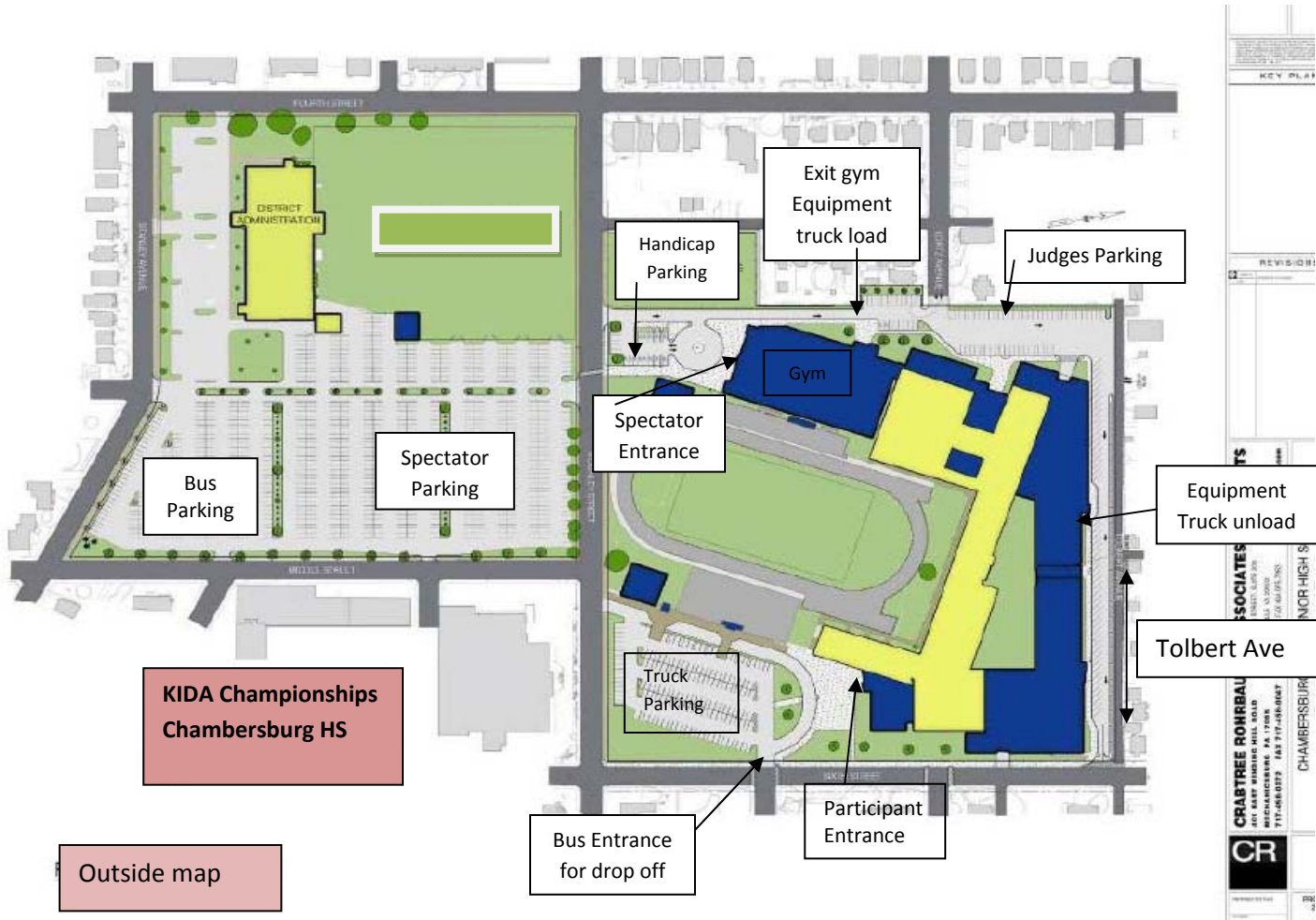

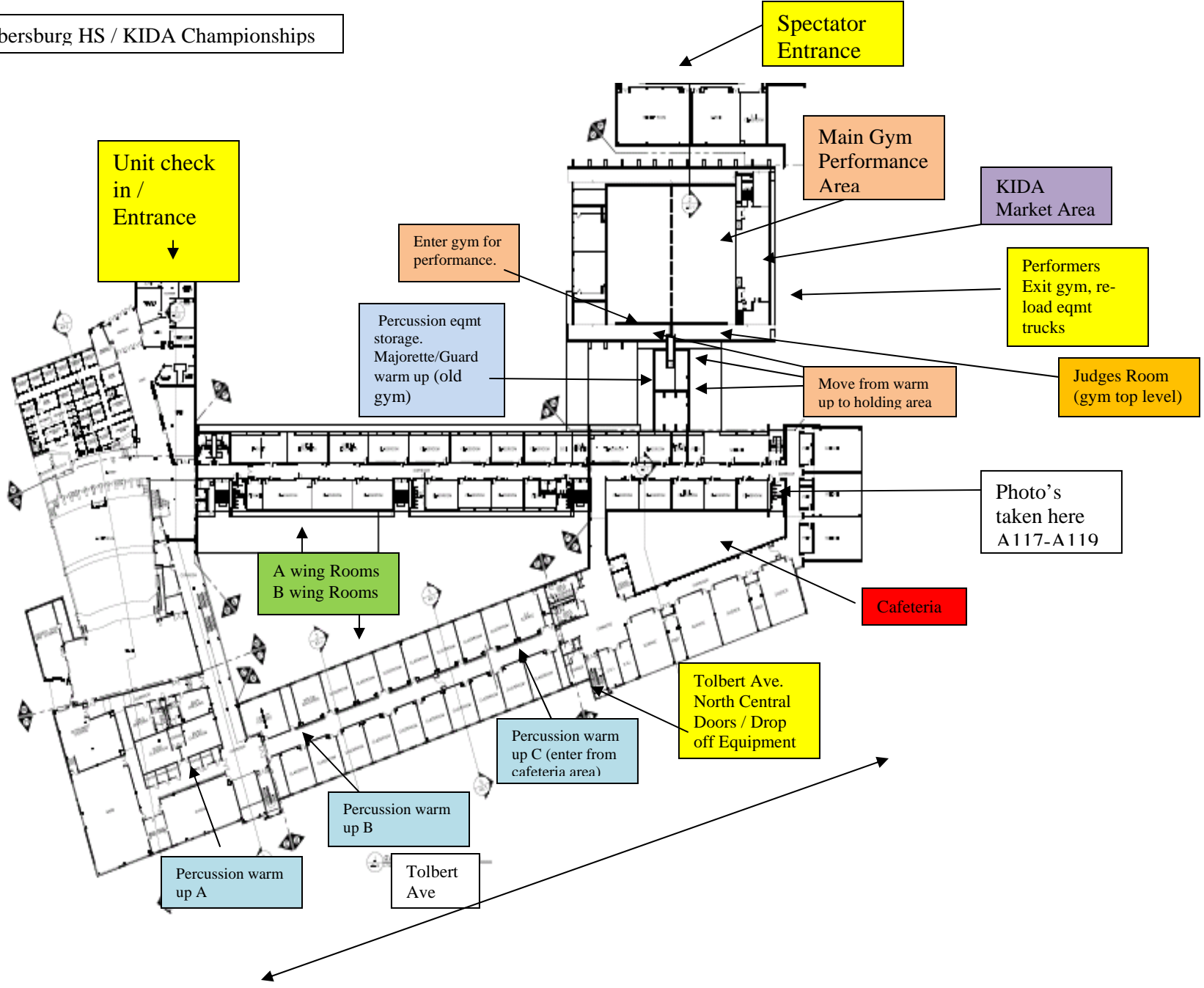
